

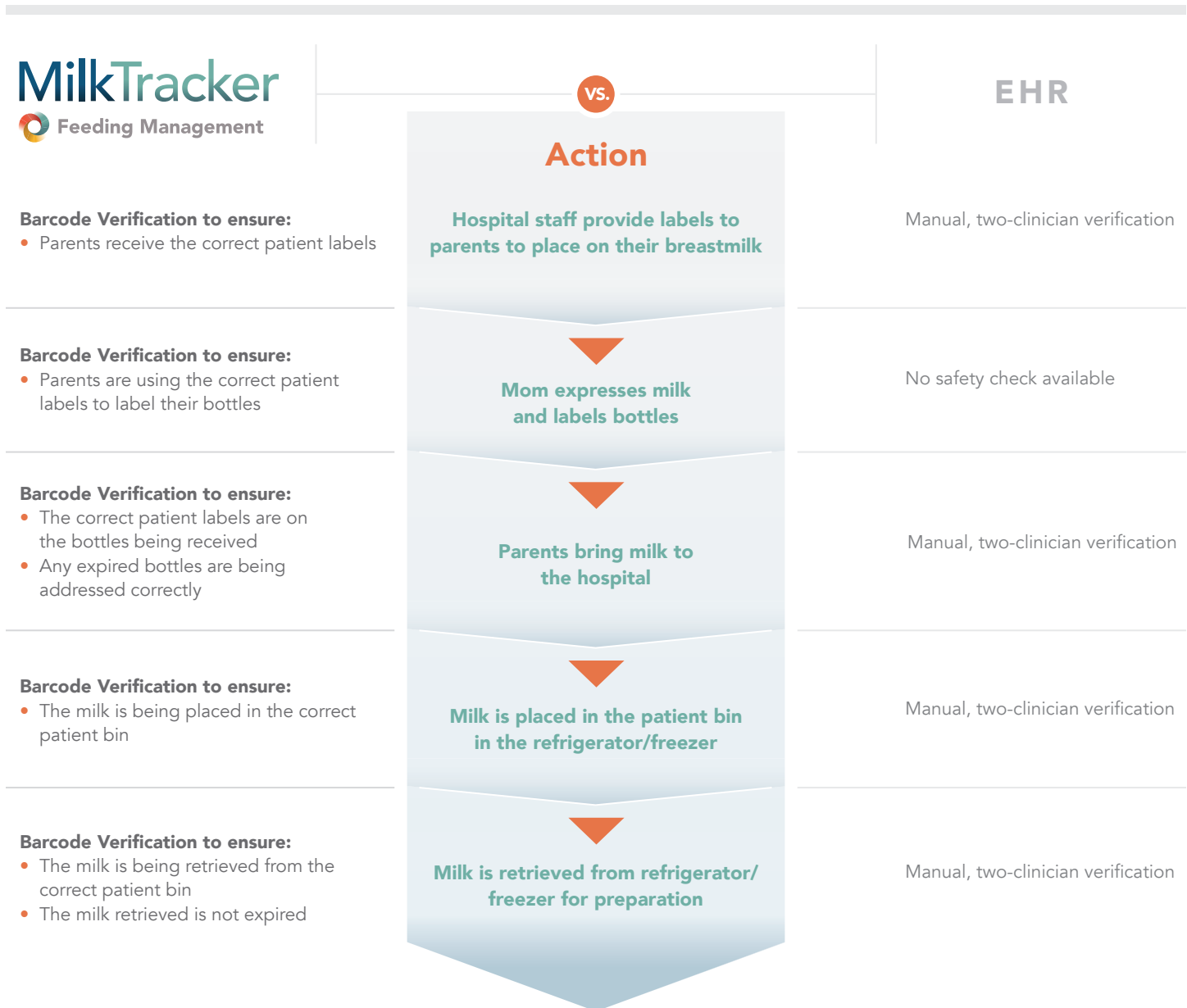
Beyond the EHR:

**Where MilkTracker
Bridges the Gap in Safety -
Every Feed, Every Time.**

Most Electronic Health Records (EHRs) out-of-the-box support for milk and formula safety is limited.

While they are designed to document care, they often lack the capabilities to manage critical components of feeding workflows, allowing for vulnerabilities throughout the process. This leaves frontline staff relying on manual processes, increasing the risk of mistakes.

The visual below compares typical EHR safety features with the end-to-end protections built into MilkTracker at each stage of the feeding management workflow. Barcode Verification to ensure:

- The milk matches the patient
- The milk is not expired
- Products being scanned have not been recalled

Preparation Support to ensure:

- The feeding being prepared matches the feeding order
- Automated recipe support provided as applicable

Barcode Verification to ensure:

- The correct milk is being placed in the correct bin
- The milk is not expired

Barcode Verification to ensure:

- The milk/feed being retrieved is for the intended patient
- The milk/feed is not expired/recalled

Barcode Verification to ensure:

- The milk/feed being fed matches the patient
- The milk/feed is not expired/recalled

Administration support to ensure:

- The prepared feed matches the active feeding order

Barcode Verification to ensure:

- The correct milk is being sent home with the correct patient
- The milk is not expired

Discharge support to ensure:

- The family is taking home every bottle

Milk is thawed, combined,
and/or fortified

Milk/Feed is placed in
the refrigerator

Milk/Feed is retrieved from the
refrigerator to feed the patient
& placed in the warmer

Milk/Feed is retrieved from the
warmer and fed to the patient

Patient is ready for discharge and
family needs to take milk home
