



## Position: MilkTracker PRN Clinical Specialist

As a Clinical Trainer and Go-Live Support Specialist for MilkTracker, you will be responsible for delivering comprehensive on-site training to healthcare professionals and providing at-the-elbow support during partner go-lives. Your role ensures a seamless transition for hospital partners by equipping their teams with the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively utilize the MilkTracker application. Through collaboration with clinical and technical teams, you will drive positive change, enhance user adoption, and support ongoing improvements in feeding management practices.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Confirmation of travel dates will be provided 2-4 weeks in advance.



- A notice period of 1-2 weeks will be given in the event of deployment cancellation when the trainer's services are not required.
